
With reference to above mentioned subject.

2. That Punjabi will be compulsory upto 10th class in your school and C.B.S.E. New Delhi will be responsible for making arrangement for Punjabi Examination and if not, the no objection certificate will be taken back.
3. That after the affiliation with C.B.S.E. New Delhi, the school management will be responsible for paying the teaching and non-teaching staff the salary and other allowances as per Govt. employees. If not, the no objection certificate will be taken back.
